The Beluga River gas field, a formation approximately 7.5 miles long by 2.5 miles wide, was discovered in 1962. It fuels the nearby power plant that is Anchorage's main source of electricity. Hilcorp Alaska has plans to drill two J-pad wells in the Beluga River Unit and construct a mobile grind-and-inject facility for treating and disposing of waste. Nearby, the Ivan River Unit produced 2.4 bcf from five wells last year.
